We will set up tables in the room **101,102, and 107**, depending on the topics.

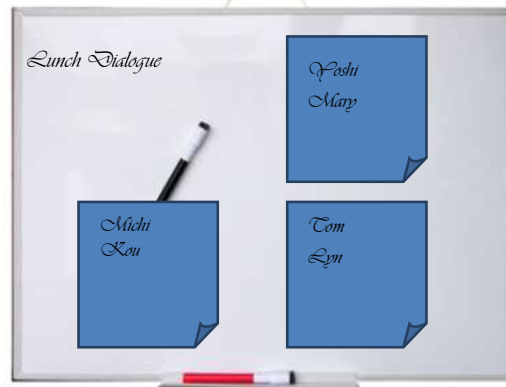
■ What are the dialogue topics?
